College Board Score Information (SAT, PSAT, AP)

Please note, students will need to login to their College Board account to access these scores with the login information that they created. New Trier does not have access to login IDs or passwords. If a student needs help with the login process they must call College Board customer service at 866-630-9305.

SAT and PSAT results:

- 1. Go to the Student Score Report homepage
- 2. Enter the email you used when creating the College Board account
- 3. Enter your password
- 4. If you're having trouble remembering your password click on "need help signing in?" and then "forgot password"
- Once you're signed in, your most recent score should be shown at the top of the page.
 You'll also see a Show Additional Scores option to see all your previous SAT and PSAT-related assessment scores
- 6. View your score summary and click the See Score Details option to view additional score insights
- 7. If a student is signed in but doesn't see his or her scores, it means College Board was not able to link the score report and account automatically. For security reasons, a student must verify additional information before College Board can display student scores. Students who cannot view their scores should call College Board's Student SAT Help Line at 866-756-7346.

Accessing AP Exam results:

- 1. Go to the View your AP Results page
- 2. Click on sign in on the right side of the page
- 3. Check that you can sign in to your College Board account.
 - a. Make sure that you remember your login credentials by signing in before scores are released in July. This is the same account that you use to access My AP or other College Board resources.
- 4. Make sure we have your current email address. If you've changed your email address, update it in your account.
- Don't create a new account if you already have one. Duplicate accounts can cause delays in getting your AP scores. Sign in with the same account you used to register and enroll in AP class sections.
