❖ **Grants for visiting artists, workshops and annual arts events.**

- Academic classes within the disciplines of art, dance, music, theatre, media and debate receive NTFAA grants that fund visiting artists and other professionals to enhance in-class learning. Additionally, NTFAA funds support out-of-class events like the annual NT Jazz Fest and the Trevian Invitational Debate Tournament. ❖ **Summer scholarships for continuing Fine Arts students.**

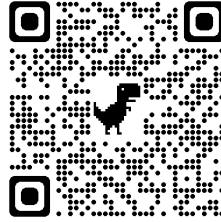
- The NTFAA offers one-time, merit scholarships to continuing Fine Art students who want to hone their craft over the summer via the Summer Scholars program. Scholarships help offset the cost of local camps or private lessons as well as travel experiences to attend fine arts camps or pre-college programs.
- In 2023, NTFAA provided scholarships for 50 New Trier students. For more about our 2023 summer scholar recipients consult our page on the NT website.

❖ **Confidential student financial assistance and support.**

- The NTFAA provides confidential student financial assistance and support, allowing students with financial needs to participate in school-sponsored trips and excursions that would otherwise prove cost-prohibitive.
- During the 2022/2023 school year we provided over \$16,000 in need-based financial aid for students to participate in the trip to New York City for NT musicians to play at Carnegie Hall, for film students to visit Los Angeles for film studio tours, and for media students to visit New York for a student film festival.

The NTFAA encourages attendance and participation in NT Fine Arts and creates community among Fine Arts families. Additionally, the NTFAA serves as a resource for NT students and parents looking for information on pursuing the arts in college (more on this at our webpage).
